



Is your résumé ready?

Review these tips and trends below to be sure!

1. Length: Does it HAVE to be one page?

No! That myth is gone. It's a-okay to increase your résumé to 2 pages. **Rule of thumb:** If you have 10+ years of work experience, go for it!

2. Video résumés are the new black!

Here are some pointers if you're requested to create a video: Dress professionally, practice your script, SMILE, share your accomplishments, practice again, and keep it under 2 minutes!

- **3.** Make sure your résumé details are consistent with your social media. *This is bigger than people think*....your education, job titles, employment dates, etc. must match. Don't accidentally give yourself a promotion on your résumé, by simply forgetting to update your LinkedIn with the same titles!
 - **4. Technical knowledge is KEY, because these skills are transferable!** Include ALL tech skills, software knowledge, coding expertise, website design knowledge, etc. that you have, even if you're *not* applying for a tech'y job. Go ahead and show off!
- **5. Tailor your résumé to EVERY job description in which you apply.** Don't use the same resume for each application! Take the time to include relevant experience to your résumé to sync with the job in which you're applying. *Tip: Just don't lie....you will get caught!*
